Dear Mr. Parks:

The Gaming Control Board's Enforcement Division has reviewed your information regarding the game, "Extra Bet." "Extra Bet" is played using 1, 2, 6, or 8 standard decks of 52 cards where the dealer hits or stands on soft 17 and blackjack pays 3 to 2 or 6 to 5.

Your modification of the standard game of Blackjack offers an optional side wager that may be placed after the player receives their first card. If the first card dealt to the player is a 10 value card, the player may place the "Extra Bet" wager. Additionally, the player must pay the casino an amount equal to 20% of the "Extra Bet" wager. Any "Extra Bet" wagers made are then added to the player's main Blackjack wager and will be paid or taken according to the final Blackjack hand outcome.

The Gaming Control Board's Technology Division reviewed the mathematical analysis certification from a Nevada Independent Test Laboratory. They determined that the mathematical percentages of the player payback and house advantage of the paytables are between 5.554% and 5.950% which is within the Board's required percentage hold.

Approval is granted to operate "Extra Bet." As "Extra Bet" is a modification of the statutorily approved game of Blackjack, a field trial will not be necessary.
